- iMatriculations/Foundation with a minimum Cumulative Grade
 Point Average (CGPA) of 2.00 or its equivalent; or
- A Diploma (Level 4, Malaysia Qualifications Framework, MQF)
 with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 or its equivalent.
